In this matter, the Court has passed several orders for registration of qualified and registered medical practitioner. and for prohibiting those who are not qualified and are unregistered, or those who have practicing medicines, having qualifications in other fields. The orders have been passed, in pursuance to the directions issued by the Supreme Court in D.K. Joshi Vs. State of U.P. and others [2000 (5) SC 80].

There are reports in the newspapers that large number of unauthorized, unqualified and unregistered persons are still practicing modern medicine. It is alleged that they are practicing in connivance with the Chief Medical Officers of the State, and his staff.

The Chief Secretary and the Prinicpal Secretary (Medical Health) are directed to comply with the orders passed by the Court, prohibiting the unauthorized. unregistered and unqualified persons, to practice modern

medicine.
