UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following  
 O R D E R

This Court vide its order dated 06.09.2010 had declined the request made by the petitioner-Association to withdraw the special leave petitions and further issued notice to the Ministry of Health, Government of India through its Secretary to file an appropriate affidavit explaining as to what action has been taken against the unqualified medical practitioners (quack Doctors) practising in the various Districts of the State of Tamil Nadu.

Learned counsel for the State of Tamil Nadu submits that the State has taken action against the 618 unqualified medical practitioners (quack doctors) from 03.06.2010 to 25.09.2013.

Since the State has started criminal proceedings against these unqualified medical practitioners (quack Doctors) in our opinion, no further action required to be taken in the present special leave petitions. Accordingly, the special leave petitions are disposed of as infructuous.

If for any reason, the petitioner-Association feels that there are some more unqualified medical practitioners (quack doctors) practising in the various Districts of the State of Tamil Nadu, they are at liberty to bring it to the notice of the concerned authorities so that the appropriate action can be taken against those doctors also.

Ordered accordingly.
